## **Head Teacher's Weekly Update**

Dear Families,

What a fantastic half term we have had here at St Wilfrid's. It has been a pleasure to see all of our pupils strive to do their very best and to achieve and to grow over the last 8 weeks. I am sure that they are very much ready for a break over half term.

Next half term, we will be making a few changes to our school day that I wanted to share with you.

## Changes to our school routines

As you will be aware, we are a busy school and as such we are continually looking to refine our procedures in order to support a calm and orderly environment. One particular area that we have been reviewing is around lunch times.

We are pleased to announce that, following the half term break, we will be moving to a single lunch service, which will be slightly offset by Reading Time. The timings of this can be seen below; the start and finish time of our school day and lesson durations are unaffected by this change. We believe that there are a number of important benefits to this, which include:

- Higher levels of staff supervision as we are operating one rather than two lunchtimes
- Less disruption to learning as lessons will not be taking place whilst other pupils are enjoying their lunchbreak
- More opportunities for pupils to participate in extra-curricular activities, as more staff will be available to lead these
- Greater access to outdoor facilities at lunchtime
- More opportunities for academic support, again as more staff will be on hand to support pupils
- All pupils still benefit from a long lunchbreak

However, it will involve some changes for pupils, which will include a reduction in breaktime service. As all pupils will be having lunch earlier, there is less need for pupils to purchase food at breaktime.

- Breaktime service in the new café will be available for our Year 11 pupils only
- All pupils will continue to access free breakfast before school in Saints' Café from 0815







The new café, as part of our recent extension, along with our 'Pod' will support us to serve more pupils in a shorter space of time and allow pupils time outdoors to get some fresh air. As winter approaches, please ensure that your child brings a coat to school so that they are warm when using our outdoor social spaces.
